Guidelines You Need To Know

Individuals, state-chartered banks and holding companies of national banks may contribute to more than one state PAC in any year. A designated consent form allowing solicitation of bank employees for a federal PAC does not prevent your bank from contributing to CBPAC, a state PAC.
