Monetary Policy Implications for Low Inflation and Global Turbulence

Craig Dismuke, Vining Sparks

Already, 2016 has brought high levels of global market turbulence. Despite this, the U.S. economy has continued to churn along at a moderate rate of expansion allowing the Fed to finally end, for now, the era of Zero-Interest-Rate Policy (ZIRP), raising rates for the first time in almost a decade. They did so based on the theory that a lower unemployment rate will inevitably translate into higher wages and inflation. The focus for Fed officials and the markets in 2016 will be inflation, if it will finally gain traction or not. In this presentation; we will 1) highlight the various factors affecting inflation, 2) illustrate why the theory may prove unreliable, and 3) discuss the potential implications for monetary policy and interest rates.
